Managed by a Charitable Trust and staffed entirely by volunteers, the Theatre is operated for the benefit of the performing arts community. Created from a late Georgian (1834) Grade 2 listed barn and stables, the Theatre has been designed to provide first class professional facilities giving users a full - scale theatre experience at modest cost.

Seating up to 110 and with a stage area of 70 sqm, high end LED lighting, surround sound equipment and two HD projectors that can be used for scenic projection, films and other video presentations, the Theatre caters for the full range of amateur and professional drama production. Foyer and café areas are regularly used for art exhibitions, and the Theatre supports shows in the nearby Priory Park. Front of house services are provided by The Friends of the Theatre who also helped fund the Malvern Festival of Ink and Curtain.

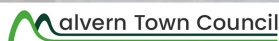
